In this remote region, the sound of a church bell had never been heard. This is the first biography of Father Galtier, the story of his struggle to survive physically and spiritually in the frontier towns on the Mississippi. It begins in the future city of St. Paul, the place with which Lucien Galtier will always be associated as it was he who provided its name. Marianne Luban looks at this proud and sometimes prickly man, who worked in often-uncomfortable circumstances on the frontier. . .
