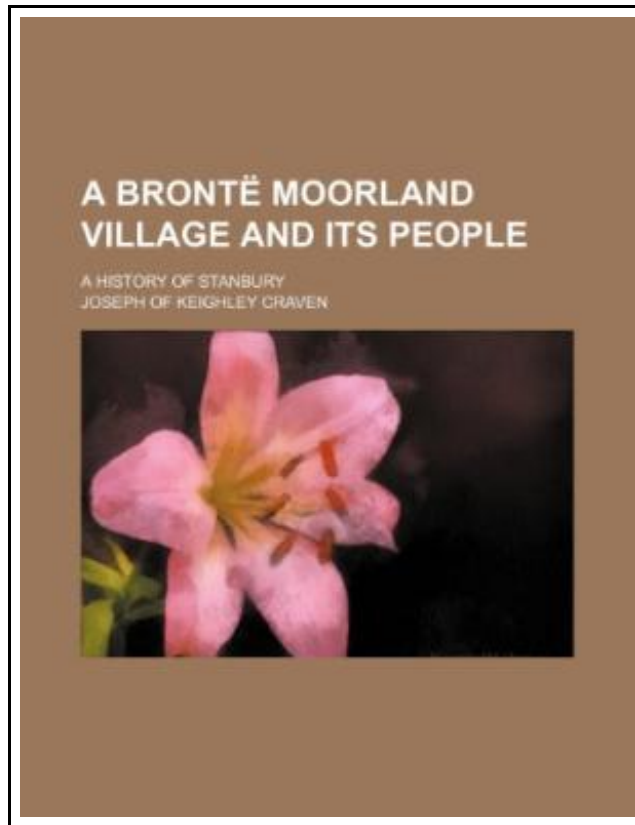

It was soon after burnt down. Mr. Timothy Feather re-built the mill, but it was burnt down again. Then Messrs. Turner bought it again, but sold it to Messrs. Crabtree Brothers and Sugden.
