This work of creative nonfiction follows the life of Elias Lnnrot from his childhood as a son of a poor country tailor, his education in bo and Helsinki supported by many scholarships, and his relationship with the wealthy and cosmopolitan Trngren family who encouraged and supported his dream of collecting the ancient Finnish folk poetry. The story focuses on the period from 1828 to 1845, when Lnnrot traveled to eastern and northern Finland, Lapland, and Russian Karelia on foot, on skis, by rowboat, on horseback, and by sledge searching out the...
